Emergency Plan

Emergency plans fall under two categories: Evacuation of building and Lockdown.

Procedure:

- 1. Evacuation of building
 - a. Group Care Under 36 Months
 - i. Educator will conduct head count and place children in stroller
 - ii. Educator will grab emergency kit, attendance list, and walkie talkie (located at exit)
 - iii. Educator will bring all children outside of fence and walk to lot on corner of Third Avenue and Cameron Street
 - iv. Educator will conduct head count and check off on attendance list
 - v. Educator will call 911 if they are the first group to arrive at meeting spot
 - vi. Families will be called to be notified of situation and asked to pick up children
 - b. Group Care 30 Months to School Age
 - i. Educator will line children up at exit and conduct head count
 - ii. Educator will grab emergency kit, attendance list, and walkie talkie (located at exit)
 - iii. Educator will bring all children outside of fence and walk to lot on corner of Third Avenue and Cameron Street
 - iv. Educator will conduct head count and check off on attendance list
 - v. Educator will call 911 if they are the first group to arrive at meeting spot
 - vi. Families will be called to be notified of situation and asked to pick up children

2. Lockdown

- a. Group Care Under 36 Months
 - i. Educator will lock all exits in vicinity
 - ii. Educator will use lockdown code word via walkie talkie (keeping in contact with other staff) while getting emergency kit and attendance list
 - iii. Educator will bring children to area away from windows

- iv. Educator will conduct head count and check off on attendance list
- v. Educator will call 911
- b. Group Care 30 Months to School Ages
 - i. Educator will lock all exits in vicinity
 - ii. Educator will grab emergency kit and attendance list
 - iii. Educator will bring children to area away from windows
 - iv. Educator will conduct head count and check off on attendance list
