BENEDRYL AND TYLENOL

Children's Benedryl and children's Tylenol will be kept on site and brought on walks in case of immediate, severe spiked fever or allergic reaction.

Procedure:

1. Parents will sign consent form upon entry to centre. The form will require you to give or to not give consent to administer Children's Benedryl (for allergic reaction) or Children's Tylenol (for immediate, severe spiked fever)
2. If a parent does not give consent, no medicine shall be given.
3. If not an emergency situation, a staff will contact a parent before administering medication.
4. If medication is given in an emergency situation (ie. Severe reaction to bee sting), staff will immediately call ambulance. Parents will be contacted after ambulance is called if staff are able to, otherwise the staff will call as soon as possible.
